We would like you to:



Always follow instructions from staff.

Speak out when something isn't right.

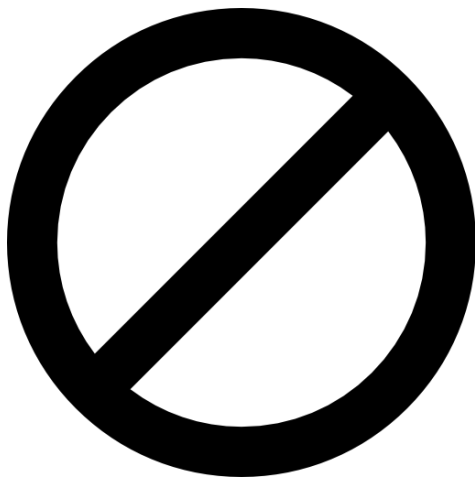


Treat the spaces and equipment with respect.

The following is **not allowed**:



No smoking or vaping.

No drinking alcohol.

No illegal substances.

No carrying illegal items.

Behaviour

We expect you to:



Respect and celebrate difference in Roundhouse spaces and activities.

Appreciate that everyone is different.



Not to discriminate against anyone.

Treat staff and other young people with respect.




Understand everyone has the right to feel safe from aggressive or intimidating behaviour.



Report any incidents of bullying and / or harassment to a member of Roundhouse staff.

Even if you are just a witness.

We expect all young people to follow the behaviours set out in this code of conduct. 

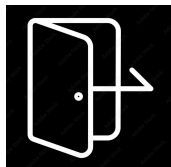
If you do not meet the code of conduct we may take the following measures:
