Founded in 2006 by Artistic Director Lindon Barr, Elementz is an award-winning Hip Hop and Street Dance company. What began as a collective of friends has grown into a London-based company that has welcomed over 150 dancers and trained nearly 300 Academy students - many of whom remain part of the Elementz family today.

As a theatre company, Elementz has performed at festivals and venues worldwide, from Breakin' Convention and the Royal Opera House to the HHI World Championships in Las Vegas, the Stockholm Fringe Festival, and the Bay Music Awards in Malta. Other highlights include the IDO World Hip Hop Championships (Poland), Rock the Circus (German Tour), and appearances at Sadler's Wells, Hammersmith Apollo, and Indigo2.
